

Context

Countries are making great efforts to mainstream educational opportunities and provide education for all and work for the respect of the right to education for the vulnerable groups. However, illiteracy among girls and women, in addition to children and young who do not attend school or drop out of school, is still one of the major challenges facing the educational systems of many countries of the Islamic world. This situation negatively affects the course of development in these countries for the present and for the future.

Aware of this situation that hinders development efforts, and in line with the International Education 2030 Agenda, ICESCO, within the framework of its new vision, pays great attention to encouraging good experiences, in the field of literacy and informal education for the benefit of girls and women.

In this regard, ICESCO awards a prize for the pioneering initiatives in the field of literacy and non-formal education dedicated to groups who have not enrolled in school or drop out of school especially girls and women, implemented by NGOs and civil society organizations.

Prizes are awarded to the best three initiatives, according to the three working languages of the organization (Arabic, English, and French). The amount of each one is (3000) three thousand US dollars, in addition to (10) ten tablets and certificates of appreciation granted by ICESCO to the three winners during one of the major conferences or events organized by the Organization.

Objective



Encouraging best practices in the areas of literacy and nonformal education, especially for girls and women, mainly those implemented by NGOs or civil society organizations.

- Distinguished capabilities of Member States in preparing policies, strategies and plans for literacy and non-formal education for girls and women;
- Exemplary experiences and pioneering practices in the areas of literacy and non-formal education, implemented by civil society and non-governmental organizations for the benefit of girls and women.

Application

The application should include:



A literacy or non-formal education program implemented by non-governmental organizations or civil society organizations for the benefit of girls and women:

- The constituting documents of the organization or association;
- A brief summary of the work, activities and objectives othe association or organization;
- Priority is given to exemplary and sustainable experiences in the areas of literacy or non-formal education for girls and women;
- Implementation of large and effective activities in the field of literacy or nonformal education for girls and women;
- Special attention to ethical dimensions and values in projects and applications.

Quantitative results:

- Number of female beneficiaries (including female beneficiaries in literacy or non-formal education centers, the newly beneficiaries of literacy, and the staff in charge of supervision and oversight);
- Literacy and post-literacy educational materials (such as textbooks, audiovisual media, etc.);
- Statistics on the evolution of literacy activities over time.
